Father's Day

It took a mother to bring equity to fathers.

As she sat in church 100 years ago in Spokane, Wash., Sonora Smart Dodd listened to a sermon about Mother's Day. It made her wonder why there was no Father's Day. Dodd, one of six children, was determined to find a way to honor her father, who raised the family after Dodd's mother died. That year, 1909, Dodd took her concerns to the Spokane Ministerial Alliance and suggested that fathers have their day. Her idea gained support. On June 19, 1910, Spokane recognized the first Father's Day on record. Dodd, who had a son of her own, must have appreciated it when President Calvin Coolidge approved a nationwide celebration of Father's Day in 1924.

Dodd, an Arkansas native, was 96 when she died in 1978.
